After a few days lift over that bucket. You will see that the grass is not as green and fresh as it was earlier. If we leave the bucket for more than a week. Then you will notice that grass will become very dull or even withered. The grass becomes dull because it cannot produce its food without sunlight. Now reverse the experiment. And lift the bucket. Just in a few days, the same grassy patch will begin to turn green again. This process of food production with sunlight and water is called photosynthesis.

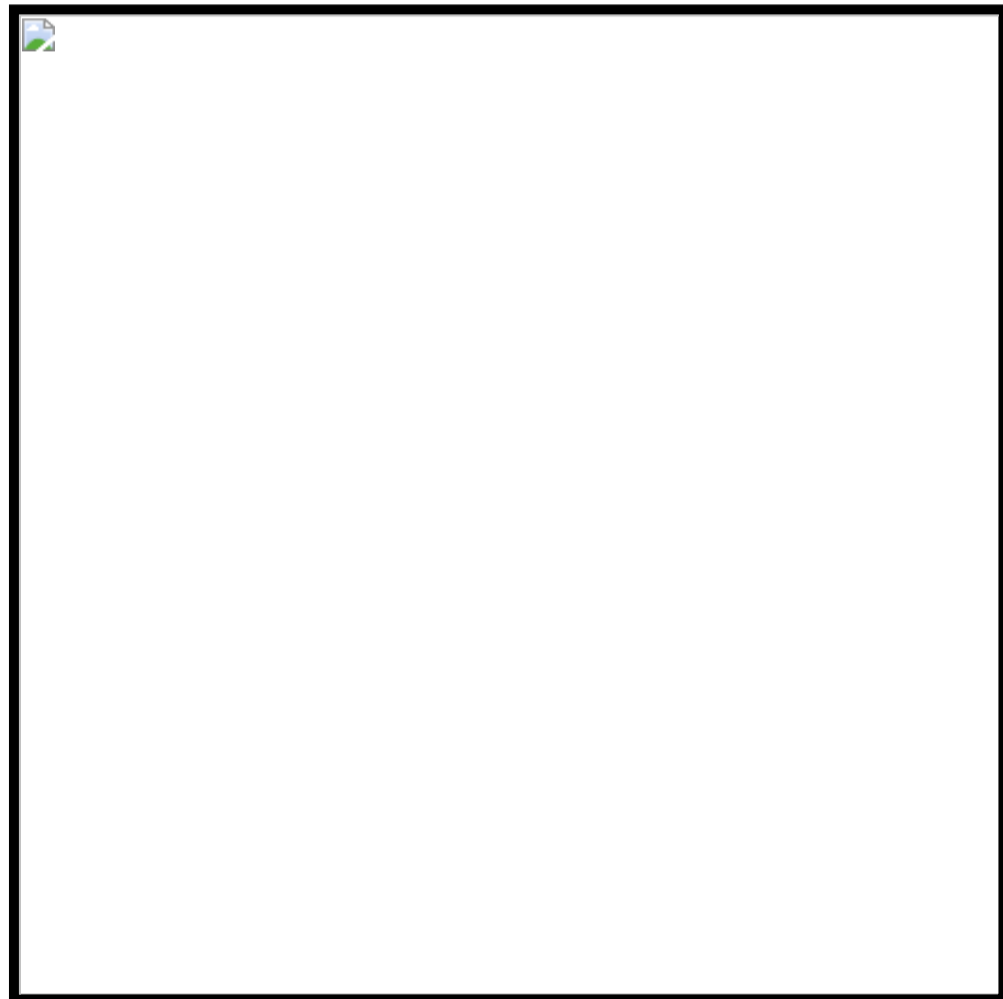
